







Colorado Trout Unlimited's vision for a youth camp has endured for 14 vears. Since its initiation in 2006. nearly 250 teens have attended the camp representing all corners of the state of Colorado and states beyond.

Campers complete a week-long program that balances STEM-based conservation education with building and improving fly fishing skills. They participate in hands-on conservation activities and receive one-on-one and group instruction in the art of fly fishing.
