Observe stream as a scientist, artist and angler

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Colorado Trout Unlimited:
 - -Volunteer training
 - -Provide STREAM Girls equipment kit to chapter
 - -Connect chapter to GSCO
 - -Advertise within CTU social media/website
 - -Recruit from STREAM Girls volunteer pool
 - -Volunteer communications

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

TU Chapter:

- -Recruit additional volunteers from their chapter's region
- -Help provide programming
- -Identify venue
- -Identify event leader from chapter

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Girl Scouts of Colorado:
 - -Recruit girl scout participants
 - -Provide promotion of the event
 - -Provide GSCO staff, if needed

FINDING A VENUE

- Indoor facility to accommodate 40-50 peoples (24 girl scouts, ~15 scout volunteers and parents, 10 volunteers – site to gather, eat lunch, tie flies, conclude day with patch ceremony)
- Restrooms
- Parking for 20-30 vehicles
- Safe stream access
- Open area for casting instruction
